
2025 UK OSPAs Thought Leadership Summit Programme Announced

Did you know? - The Great Firewall of China

The Great Firewall of China processes over 750 million surveillance camera feeds daily, serving as a powerful tool for monitoring and controlling Internet traffic within the country. Beyond filtering online content, it employs advanced AI to analyse footage from millions of security cameras, enabling real-time facial recognition, movement tracking, and the detection of suspicious behaviour. This integration of digital and physical surveillance makes it one of the most comprehensive monitoring systems in the world.
